


Insert the 5 wheels into the appropriate slots in the base.


Push them all the way in until you hear the "CLICK" of the correct engagement in place.



Insert the support piston into the base seat, paying attention to the direction.




Insert the chair body into the support piston.



Sit carefully on the chair so as to complete the coupling of the parts.







Pull the lever upwards to operate the chair lifting piston.




Lift the weight slightly off the seat so that the chair can be raised.




Impress all the weight on the seat so that the chair can be lowered.
