Company Overview & Project Needs

Summit Credit Union has been serving Wisconsin for over 75 years and is one of the largest credit unions in the state. The company is rapidly growing with 38 locations across the state. This growth led Summit Credit Union to move from 6 different locations into one corporate headquarters in 2019.

The clients primary driver was keeping costs low, while still creating an innovative, dynamic and colorful space for employees with a variety of conference rooms styles that cultivated collaboration and cross-functionality across the organization. Individual spaces needed to be ergonomically enhanced to ensure comfort throughout the day.

The Results

Furniture selections were made by a project team who reviewed the overall style, color, and functionality of pieces.

AIS's Divi Open Plan System was chosen for the employee individual workstations. The panels were coupled with Calibrate Pull-out storage and screens to create additional privacy. Conference rooms used a variety of Day-to-Day and Calibrate tables. These were complemented with Sulli and Triad seating.
